"Chains at the Door"

A pastor once visited a small village where he noticed an old church with a rusted set of chains hanging beside the front door. Curious, he asked the caretaker about them.

The man smiled and said,

“Many years ago, this church was used during a war. Soldiers broke in and locked the doors to stop people from gathering and worshiping. But the people came anyway—meeting outside, whispering prayers, and risking everything to hear the Word of God. When the war ended, those chains were broken. The people placed them here—not to remember the pain, but to celebrate the freedom.”
